## Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Thursday, December 1st to Friday, December 2nd, 2022, among a sample of 1162 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Ontario. The survey was conducted using automated telephone interviews (Smart IVR). Respondents were interviewed on landlines and cellular phones. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Ontario.
The margin of error for the poll is $+/-2.9 \%$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.
